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## ACCOMPLISHMENTS

The Corps has provided technical support to state and local agencies for Remedial Action Plans at eighteen of the 31 U.S. Areas of Concern. This program has provided the planning and design for contaminated sediment cleanup projects that have been constructed under EPA's Legacy Act program, including the cleanups on the Detroit River (Black Lagoon) and Ashtabula River. This RAP program has also helped plan sediment cleanup projects under consideration for Legacy Act funding at Grand Calumet River, Waukegan Harbor and Milwaukee Estuary AOCs.

RAP program technical support has also included efforts to control pollution sources and monitor recovery of completed actions. A stream restoration project designed under this program and constructed with state and local funding on Eighteenmile Creek, New York was recognized with several environmental awards.



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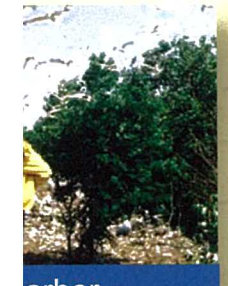
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
