

Fish raising project in Olcott approved

The county Legislature approved a plan Tuesday that would allow salmon and trout to be raised in Eighteenmile Creek and released in Lake Ontario at Olcott.

The fish would be provided by the state Department of Environmental Conservation, and the county would use \$3,000 collected from fishing activities to purchase metal pens to raise the fish in before they are released in the lake.

The measure was sponsored by Legislator John Syracuse, R-Newfane.
